Banana Cake Recipe

Try this delicious recipe to make good use of over ripe bananas!

Ingredients

140g butter

- 130g caster sugar
- 2 large eggs, beaten
- 140g self-raising flour
- 1 tsp baking powder

2 very ripe bananas, mashed

Method



- Heat the oven to 180C (160C for fan ovens)
- Butter a 2lb loaf tin and line with baking parchment
- Cream butter and caster sugar until light and fluffy, then slowly add 2 beaten large eggs with a little of the flour.
- Fold in the remaining flour, baking powder and mashed bananas.
- Pour the mixture into tin and bake for about 50 mins, or until cooked through. Check by testing it with a skewer (it should be able to be inserted and removed cleanly).
- Cool in the tin for 10 mins, then remove to a wire rack.
- Eat and ENJOY!
